Hy's Steakhouse This classic—and very classy—steakhouse has for decades been a hub for downtown dealmakers. Skilled servers prepare tableside Caesar salads and ensure your New York striploin, porterhouse, filet mignon or bone-in rib steak is cooked just the way you like it.

Canoe If the view from this dining gem on the 54th floor of the TD Centre doesn't sufficiently impress your guests, chef John Horne's modern Canadian cuisine sure will.

Ki Modern Japanese + Bar Fresh yet authentic Japanese flavours pervade the menu at this hot spot. It's particularly popular for lunch and post-work drinks.

Drake One Fifty It's bohemian meets business at this Financial District outpost of the artsy Drake Hotel. Leather booths, a marble bar with wooden pergola, and a colourful mural by Gary Baseman serve as the backdrop for chef Ted Corrado's cooking.

Blowfish on Bay A stunning bronze walkway sets the tone at this refined Asian restaurant, whose flavours are showcased in such dishes as coconut-battered shrimp, and gyoza with edamame and snow pea shoots.
